If you tear, deface, or make a mistake and wrongfully mark any ballot, you must return it to the election board and receive a new ballot or set of ballots.


Making selections
Offices
To vote for a person, darken the oval to the left of the person's name. To vote for presidential electors for candidates for president and vice-president darken the oval at the left of the names of the candidates

Judicial Retention
To vote for a Justice of the Supreme Court, Judge of the Court of Appeals or District Court being retained in office darken the oval to left of the word "Yes"; to vote against retaining in office darken the oval to the left of the word "No".

Question Submitted
To vote in favor of any question submitted upon this ballot, darken the oval to the left of the word "Yes"; to vote against it, darken the oval to the left of the word "No".

Optional write-in
To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write the person's name in the blank space, and darken the oval to the left.

To vote for presidential electors to be selected by candidates for president and vice-president whose names are not printed on the ballot, write the persons' names in the appropriate blank spaces and darken the oval at the left of the names of the candidates.

This amendment is to preserve constitutionally the right of the public to hunt, fish and trap wildlife subject to reasonable laws and regulations. The right of the public to hunt, fish and trap shall not modify any provision of common law or statutes relating to trespass, eminent domain or any other private property rights.</p>
